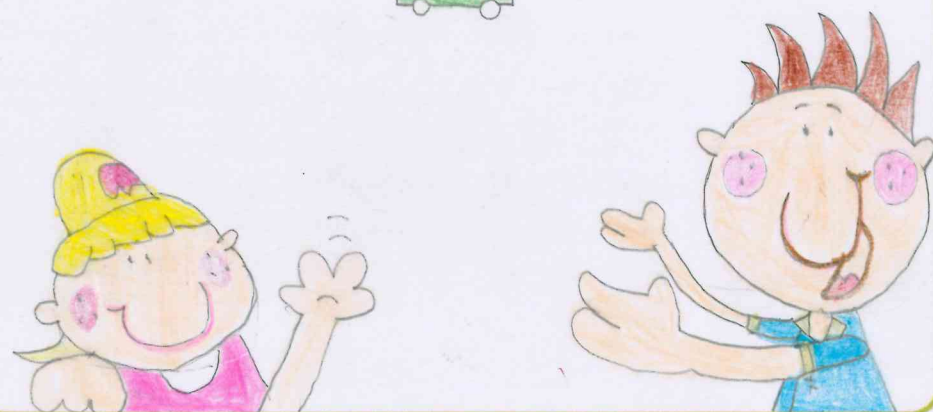
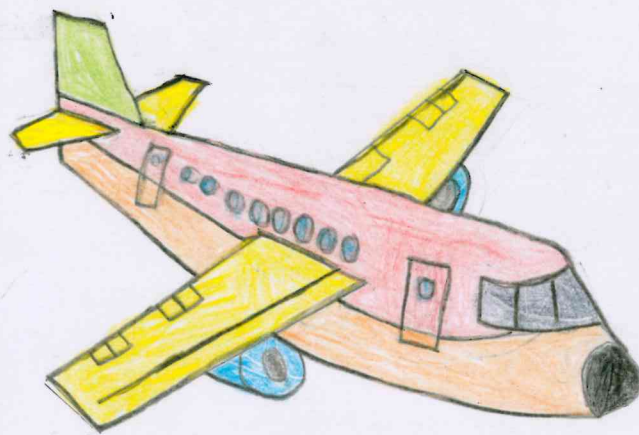
1. My favourites

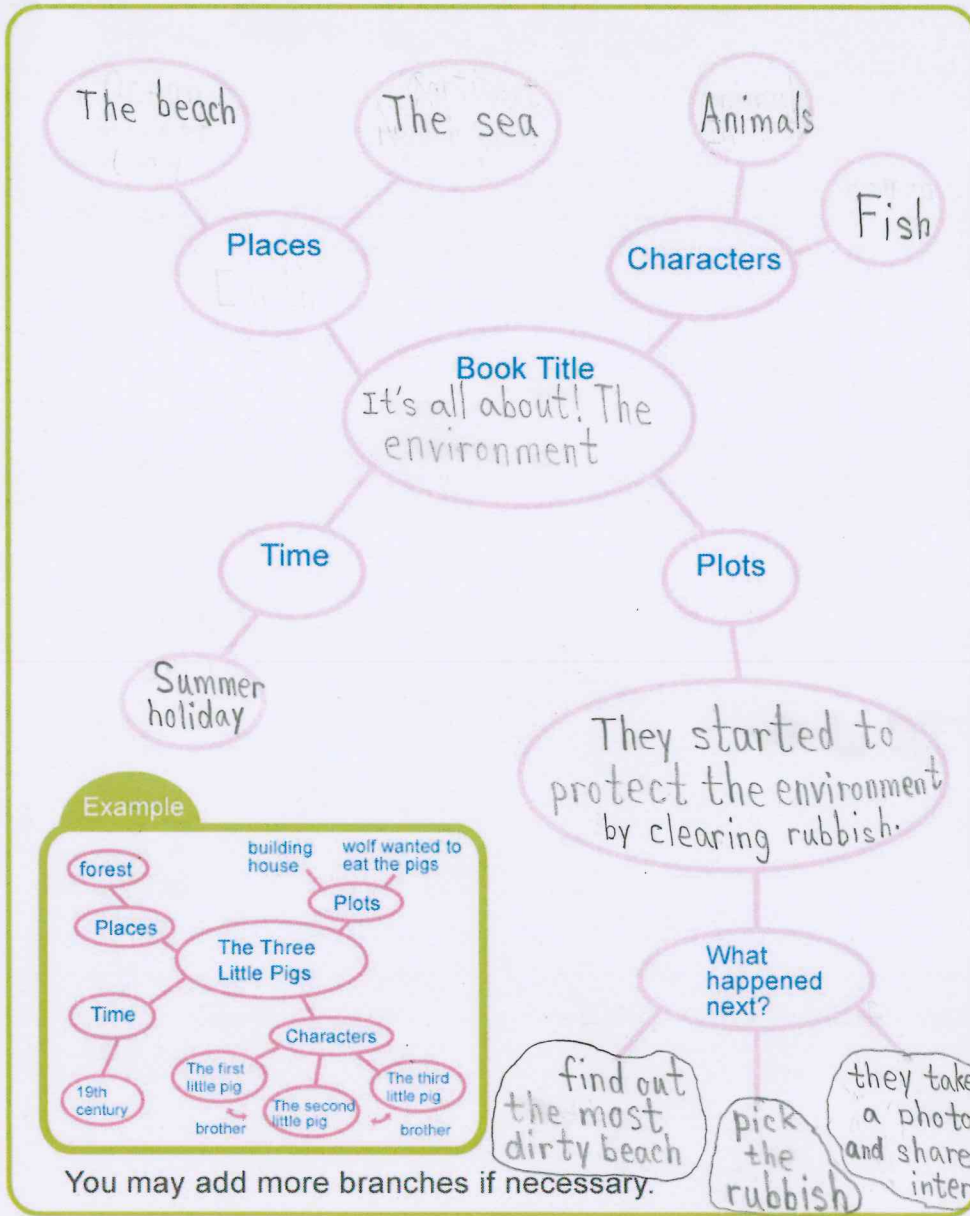
2. Design a new book cover for your favourite book.

● Why is English reading so important ?

1. Reading English helps you understand other culture better.
2. English is an international language. Many classic stories are written in English.
3. Regular English reading will really improve your English.

● Positive attitude

1. A positive reading attitude is essential to sustain our interest in English .
2. Reading is fun, as enjoyable in English as Chinese.
3. Don't worry if you don't know a word or phrase. Try to understand the whole story.

● Regular reading habit

To become a regular English reader, you should:

1. Find time to read every day, even if it's only a few minutes.
2. Set targets you can reach.
3. Find a comfortable place to read. Sit back and relax.

● Reading materials

1. Choose books that interest you and suitable for your English level.
2. Classic stories that you know are good for beginners.
3. Short English stories, fairy tales, newspapers, magazines, posters, leaflets are also good choices.

● Reading companions

1. When you find any difficult words, try to guess the meaning.
2. Only use your dictionary when the meaning of the word affects your understanding of the story.
3. Your family, schoolmates, friends or neighbours are good reading partners. Read and discuss the stories with them .
